

Mental Maths Home Learning  
Summer 1  
Year 1

Please practise these mental skills with your child at home. As a guide, between 5-10 minutes should be spent 3-4 times per week on each objective.

Week 1	<p>To identify number patterns on number lines and hundred squared. What patterns do you recognise on the number line/hundred square?</p> <p>Use the interactive 100 square to spot the patterns you can see. <a href="https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/paint-the-squares">https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-to-count/paint-the-squares</a></p>
Week 2	<p>Read and write number to 50 in digits and words. Show your child random numbers. Can they read them? Ask them to write the number in digits and in words. Look around your home, how many times can you find numbers up to 50?</p>
Week 3	<p>Identify odd/even numbers linked to counting in twos from 0 and 1. Look at the numbers of the houses on your street, how many are odd and how many are even? Is your house an odd number or an even number?</p>
Week 4	<p>Add a single digit number to any number up to 20. Choose two numbers up to 20. Can you put them into an addition number sentence. Use tens frames to support your working out.</p>
Week 5	<p>Take away a single digit number from any number up to 20. Choose two numbers up to 20. Can you put them into a subtraction number sentence? (starting with the biggest number) Use ten frames to support your working out.</p>
Week 6	<p>To measure the length of objects in centimetres. Find some objects in your home to measure with a ruler. Remember to place your ruler in the correct position, the 0 should be at one end of your object.</p>
