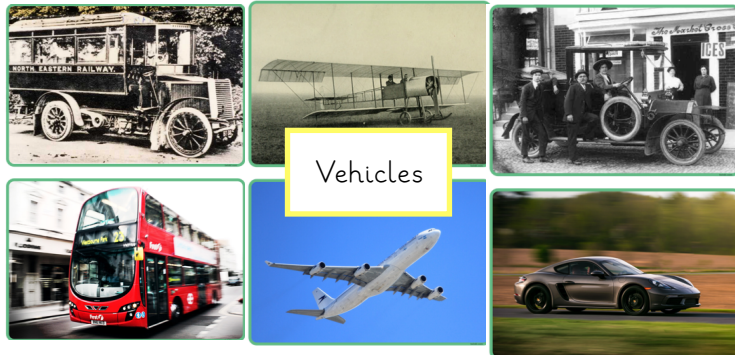

Vehicle: a form of transport.

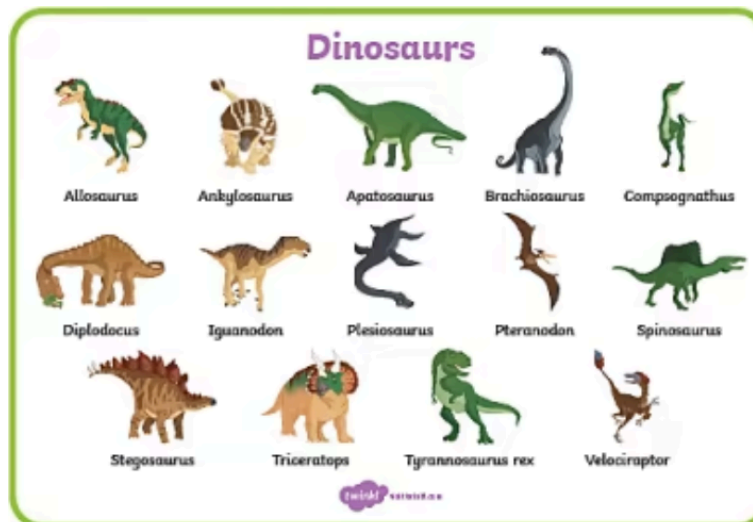
Seaside: a town that meets the sea.
