You have travelled back in time to the moment when Tutankhamun is crowned Pharaoh. Write a description of what you can see, hear and smell.



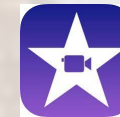

Research what Ancient Egyptian's ate. Create a menu that would have been fit for a Pharaoh!



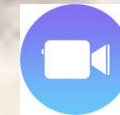
Research the Egyptian number system.
